

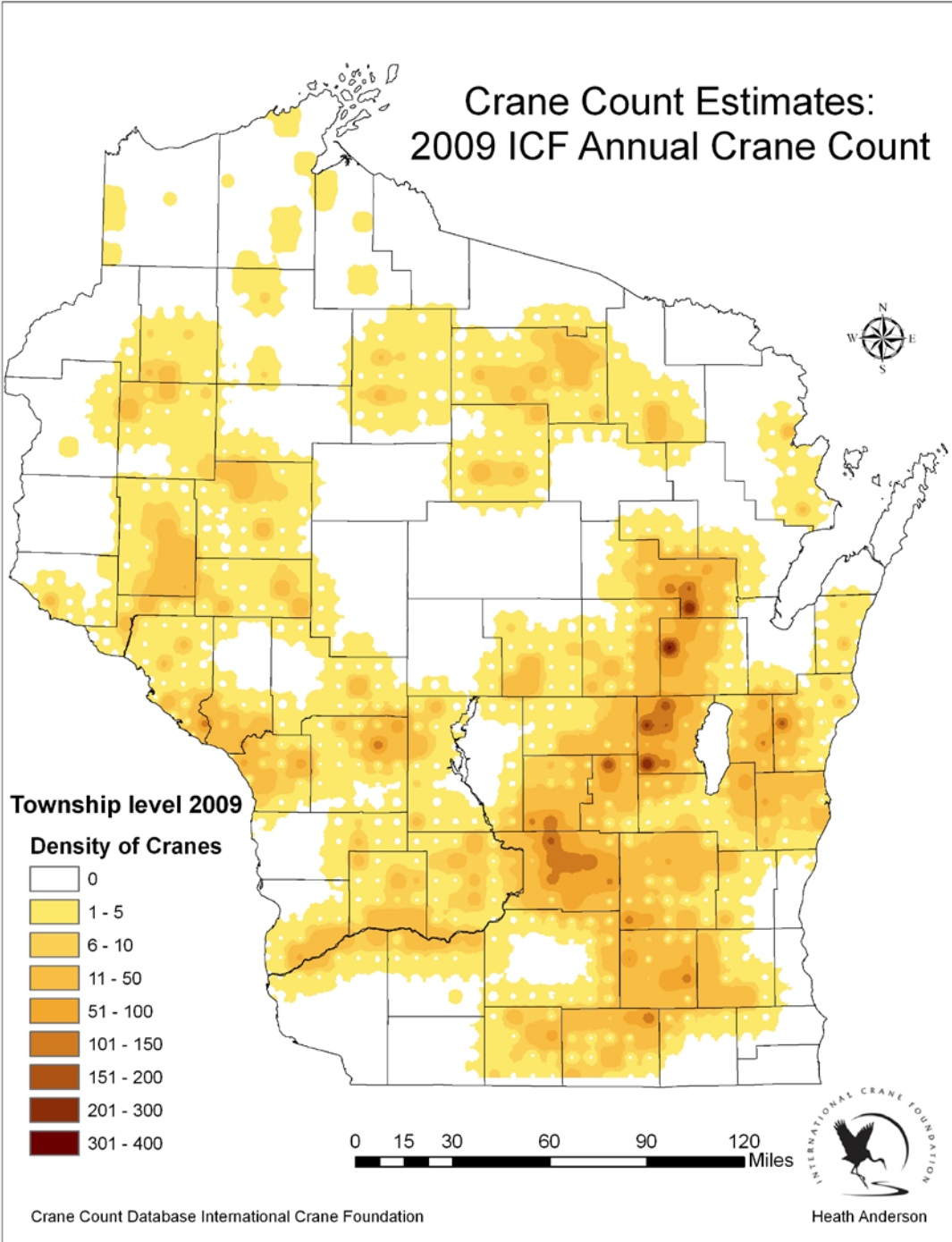
# Annual Midwest Crane Count 2009 Results

**Tables:**

The tables provide a county summary of the 2009 Crane Count data for each of the five states. The number of cranes (seen or heard) and the number of pairs, determined by unison calls, are reported.

**Maps:**

The map at left shows crane density at the township level, based on site locations in Wisconsin. The full page map below illustrates total crane sightings by county for the five state area. The number of cranes observed or heard during Crane Count does not tell us precisely how many cranes are found in any given county. Factors such as weather conditions during the count, number of sites counted, and number of observers are considered when we use Crane Count data to estimate crane population trends.
