### **Will you mail me a printed ticket?**

### **Are children allowed at *An Evening With the Cranes*?**

This event is designed for adults over 21, but no one will be excluded. Young guests will be carded upon entry and marked if under 21. Everyone, including those under the age of 21, is required to purchase a ticket for the event (\$85 for Members, \$100 for Non-Members).

**Can I bring a pet to *An Evening With the Cranes*?**

Pets are not allowed. Service animals are permitted but must remain leashed and under control at all times. If you plan to bring a service animal to the event, please contact us in advance at 608-356-9462 ext. 151.

**I am a member, but my friend is not. Can I purchase a guest ticket at the \$85 member rate?**

Yes. If you are a member, you may purchase tickets for your guests at the member rate of \$85 per ticket.

**What if I have special dietary issues?**

Restaurant staff will be present at each station to provide information about the food they are serving.

**What about inclement weather?**

The event is held rain or shine, and tickets are non-refundable.

**What should I wear?**

We encourage guests to dress up a little for this event! Think garden party or dressy casual. Comfortable shoes are recommended, as the evening requires significant walking.

**When should I arrive?**

*An Evening With the Cranes* begins at 5 p.m. Early entry is not permitted.

**What if I have mobility issues?**

Most public areas during the event are ADA accessible, and paths are paved. The International Crane Foundation has limited wheelchairs and electric scooters available for guests on a first-come, first-served basis. Sorry, no reservations. You may also bring your wheelchair or scooter.
