

An Evening with the Cranes Frequently Asked Questions

Will you mail me a printed ticket?

Yes! Your name tag is your ticket to the event and will be mailed to you with your tax letter. Be sure to bring it for express check-in. Can't find your ticket or have a name change? Please call 608-356-9462 ext. 807 or email events@savingcranes.org. Please note that tickets purchased after June 14 will be available for pickup at check-in. Tickets can also be purchased at the door the night of the event.

What can I expect if I attend An Evening with the Cranes?

Each guest will receive one commemorative glass and a name tag lanyard. Stations with appetizers, wine, craft beer and non-alcoholic beverages are placed among our crane exhibits. Along the way, you'll meet International Crane Foundation staff and learn about our work to save cranes around the world—and how you can help.

What's new this year?

Our site will be closed to visitors on June 22 until the event begins at 4 p.m. The event will run an hour earlier than in previous years, beginning at 4 p.m. and ending at 7 p.m.

Will there be a silent auction?

There will not be a silent auction this year.

Are children allowed at An Evening with the Cranes?

This event is designed for adults over the age of 21, but no one will be excluded. Young guests will be carded upon entry and marked if they are under 21. Everyone, including those under the age of 21, is required to purchase a ticket for the event (\$100 for Members, \$120 for Non-Members).

Where should I stay in Baraboo?

Can I bring a pet to An Evening with the Cranes?

Pets are not allowed. Service animals are permitted but must remain leashed and under control at all times. If you plan to bring a service animal to the event, please contact us in advance at 608-356-9462 ext. 151.

I'm a member, but my friend isn't. Can I purchase a guest ticket at the \$100 member rate?

Yes. If you are a member, you may purchase tickets for your guests at the member rate of \$100 per ticket.

What if I have special dietary issues?

Restaurant staff will be present at each station to provide information about the food they are serving.

What about inclement weather?

The event is held rain or shine, and tickets are non-refundable.

What should I wear?

We encourage guests to dress up a little for this event! Think garden party or dressy casual. Comfortable shoes are recommended, as the event requires significant walking.

When should I arrive?

An Evening with the Cranes begins at 4 p.m. Early entry is not permitted.

What if I have mobility limitations?

Most public areas during the event are ADA accessible, and paths are paved. The International Crane Foundation has a limited number of wheelchairs and electric scooters available for guests on a first-come, first-served basis. Sorry, no reservations. You may also bring your own wheelchair or scooter and are encouraged to do so.
