## How much does a ticket cost?

Tickets are \$100 for International Crane Foundation members and \$120 for nonmembers. A nonmember can become a member for \$40 or more and then purchase at the member rate. **Tickets are non-refundable.** Thank you for supporting our community fundraiser. All proceeds from the event support the International Crane Foundation's conservation efforts.

## Will you mail me a printed ticket?

Yes! Your name tag is your ticket to the event and will be mailed to you with your tax letter. Be sure to bring for express check-in. Upon arrival at the event, we will provide you with a commemorative lanyard for your nametag. For tickets purchased after June 13, nametags will not be mailed and will be available for pickup upon check-in at our registration station. NEW this year is our ticketing platform Humanitix. Your ticket confirmation email will be from order@humanitix.com.

## What can I expect if I attend An Evening with the Cranes?

*An Evening with the Cranes* will be held from 4-7 p.m. Each guest will receive one commemorative glass and a name tag lanyard. Stations with appetizers, wine, craft beer, and non-alcoholic beverages will be set up among our crane exhibits. Along the way, you'll meet International Crane Foundation staff and learn about our work to save cranes around the world—and how you can help.

## What's new this year?

New this year is the use of the ticketing platform called Humanitix. Your online ticket confirmation will come from a Humanitix email address of order@humanitix.com. Please do not delete this email, as it will contain important information regarding the event.

## Are children allowed at An Evening with the Cranes?

This event is designed for adults over the age of 21, but no one will be excluded. Young guests will be carded upon entry and marked if under 21. Everyone, including those under the age of 21, is required to purchase a ticket for the event (\$100 for Members, \$120 for Non-Members).

## Where should I stay in Baraboo?

## Can I bring a pet to An Evening with the Cranes?

Pets are not allowed. Service animals are permitted but must remain leashed and under control at all times. If you plan to bring a service animal to the event, please contact us in advance at 608-356-9462 ext. 151.

## I'm a member, but my friend isn't. Can I purchase a guest ticket at the \$100 member rate?

Yes. If you are a member, you may purchase tickets for your guests at the member rate of \$100 per ticket.

## What if I have special dietary issues?

Restaurant staff will be present at each station to provide information about the food they are serving.

## What about inclement weather?

*The safety of our guests is our top priority.* This event may be canceled if inclement weather is predicted within 5 days of the scheduled date. We will monitor weather conditions closely and provide updates as necessary. In the event of cancellation, attendees who provided an email address in the ticket-purchasing process will be notified. We will also include weather-related updates on our website. Once a ticket is purchased, no refunds will be permitted under any circumstances. Thank you for supporting our fundraiser.

## What should I wear?

We encourage guests to dress up for this event! Think garden party or dressy casual. Comfortable shoes are recommended, as the event requires significant walking.

## When should I arrive?

An Evening with the Cranes begins at 4 p.m. Early entry is not permitted.

## What if I have mobility limitations?

Most public areas during the event are ADA accessible, and paths are paved. The International Crane Foundation has a limited number of wheelchairs and electric scooters available for guests on a first-come, first-served basis. Sorry, no reservations. Guests are encouraged to bring their own wheelchair or scooter.
