

2014 Annual Midwest Crane Count Totals

Beginning in 1976 as the Columbia County Crane Survey, the Annual Midwest Crane Count has grown over nearly four decades to include portions of six states in the upper Midwest.

Crane Count data are used to study Sandhill Crane population trends and new areas where cranes are colonizing, while the survey is a

powerful tool for creating awareness about cranes and their wetland habitats. Beginning in 2012 with the inclusion of the survey's data into eBird, biologists and birdwatchers worldwide have the opportunity to use the data, which now includes sightings for other 100 bird species. 
